Dear Mr. Bates:

The Virginia Department of Transportation's (VDOT) Location and Design Division Committee has completed its review of the product, Ultra-ADA Pads. The committee has found that the product currently falls within VDOT Road and Bridge Standards, Section 200. The product also falls under 2007 VDOT Road and Bridge Specification 200 stating: "If the Contractor desires to substitute another material other than that specified, he shall submit proof that the substitute material is equal in all respects to the material specified. Proof shall be in the form of specification for the proposed substitution that may be readily compared with the specification."

As such, the product can be used in accordance with the VDOT standard and specification. An approved list does not exist for this type of product; therefore, it is recommended that the standard and specification be referred to prior to using the product on VDOT maintenance or construction projects.
